## Letter of Agreement for Non-Commercial Recreation Use Between

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Grand Junction Field Office (GJFO) and the Grand Junction Chapter of the Colorado Archaeological Society (CAS GJ)

Based on our evaluation of your proposal, your activity does not require a Special Recreation Permit (SRP).

**Type of activity:** Group outings to visit BLM public lands to learn about the past

**Location:** Lands managed by the BLM Grand Junction Field Office, including McInnis Canyons National Conservation Area and Dominguez-Escalante National Conservation Area

**Date/s:** April 4, 2016 to December 31, 2016

**Number of people:** Varies by field trip (group size ranges from 6-25 people)

**This Letter of Agreement** assumes conduct of participants is aligned with the actions listed below. If the BLM determines the conduct of participants is not consistent with this agreement, the BLM may require these outings to be authorized under a Special Recreation Permit or cease completely.

**It is hereby agreed** that certain actions are necessary to have a safe and successful outing with a minimum impact to the environment:

1. CAS GJ will take precautions to protect natural resource values, cultural or historic objects, aesthetic values, and any improvements on public lands involved. Cultural artifacts located on the surface of an archaeological site, isolated artifacts, or rock art panels are not to be disturbed. Moving or disturbing cultural

artifacts from any location is a violation of federal law. Please report vandalism of cultural properties by calling 970-244-3000.

2. The authorized party will take all reasonable measures to prevent and discourage vandalism or disorderly conduct, and when necessary, will call in appropriate law enforcement.
3. All field trips will follow the attached guidelines, which are subject to change.


